Doping control

will be executed.

Your athletes should bring their passports and accreditation cards to the doping control.

Alcohol testing

will also be done.

Smoking

In Italy it is not allowed to smoke in public places.

Juniors

Will be checked through their passports on their Junior-status.

Mobile phones

are not allowed in the competition areas.

Lay-out of the area:

Accreditation/ /Team Captains' meeting/ Doping formalities/Awards- and Closing-Ceremonies will all be held in the in the „Oval Lingotto“.

Number of participants (not yet all final entries have been sent as per the deadline of the final entries, e.g. 14th of February)

At present 34 countries are participating with a total (including approx 90 officials) of 400 persons.

Based on the present situation of entries after the qualification round the competition will continue with the 1st Elimination round with 32 archers in each category with byes at present in the Compound Junior Women and Men Division.

Of course only in the Team Captains meeting the final situation can be given.

Teams' event:

As per the present situation there will not be an official European Championship Teams in the Junior Compound Women Division. Of course especially in this division and in the Junior Compound Men Division an information about a team event can only be published after receipt of the final entries and the arrival of the teams, during the TC-meeting.

It is not possible that a junior athlete who competed in the Junior Championships, competes in the Senior Team event.

Official Practice and Equipment Inspection

Tuesday 4th of March 2008-02-15 9.00-12.00 hrs

The teams will be called alphabetically

All Team Members should wear their Team Uniform at the Equipment Inspection.

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance.

For the semifinals and finals it is required that the name of the athlete participating, is printed on the back of the shirt.

The “back numbers” of the athletes will only be handed out when all the athletes have arrived and the draw has been made. These must be worn by the athletes as long as they are in the competition in such a way that the number is easy recognisable. (Preferably on the thigh so that also the Press can easily identify the athlete). After the qualification round new “back numbers” will be issued for the athletes in the elimination rounds.

Also all spare equipment must be brought by the athletes to the Equipment inspection.

We kindly ask you to co-operate fully with the requirements set forth by the Tournament Judge Commission.

During the Equipment inspection also a copy of the scorecard to be used will be handed out. There will be a single paper scorecard; the athletes will have to use the electronic system. During the equipment inspection athletes will get the necessary instructions for this electronic system..

Also please ask your athletes to mark the holes!

Competition schedule:

See the attached (preliminary) schedule.

The real final starting times for the various rounds, where not specifically indicated in the program, will be announced during the event shortly before the start of the specific round.

Target assignment

The target-assignment list will be handed out at the Team Captains’ meeting.

Jury of Appeal:

The members of the Jury of Appeal will be announced during the Team Captains’ meeting

Appeal procedure:

The times for an Appeal mentioned in the Appeal form must be considered

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A deposit of Euro 50.- must be paid to the EMAU TD or to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

When the Appeal is accepted by the Jury of Appeal, the money will be returned.

In case of non-acceptance of the Appeal, the money is not returned.

Article 3.13.2.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and/or the Jury within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. The written appeal must be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first, to allow the Jury to come to a decision before the beginning of the next round of the competition.

Article 3.13.4:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and submitted to the appellant, the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the Organizers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition or before the awarding of prizes.

Transport schedule

The time-schedule for transport from the various hotels to the „Oval Lingotto“ and the Opening ceremony as well as to the Closing part, will be handed out upon arrival at accreditation.

Opening-Ceremony

The **Opening Ceremony** will take place in town next to the river Po, in the evening of Tuesday 4th of March at 17.45 hrs and will take approx 1 hrs. It will be in the open air, so please see to it that the athletes have the proper warm clothing with them.

Teams who might want to use their own transport should be present at the place of the Opening Ceremony at the latest at 17.30 hrs. (Parking-permit is necessary)

It is, however, preferred that those teams also use the OC-transport.

The **Medal ceremonies** will take place as mentioned in the Program

The **Closing-Ceremony** will take place just after the awards ceremony on Saturday in “Oval Lingotto”.

Closing party

See the transport schedule in the program for transport to Closing party at 20.30 hrs.

Lunches

Will be handled through the accreditation card.

Water

Will be available on the FOP.

Storage of bow cases etc at the competition area:

Secured storage of bow cases and spare equipment during the competition is available at the competition area, easily accessible by the Team Captains.

Team Captains please be aware of where the equipment of your Team is stored, so in case you need to bring in spare equipment you can easily find it.

“Lost and found” area, noticeboards

will be at the information desk. Please check there for lost property.

Found property please also bring there.

Result lists will also be published on noticeboards in the competition hall and will be available in the FOP through monitors.

Mailboxes/Informations/Results

Information and results per round, will be placed in the mailboxes. Results will also be published on noticeboards in the various hotels.

Please see to it that only the Team Captains collect the information at the mailboxes, so that necessary information does not get lost because not authorised persons collect the information.

Littering:

Please ask your athletes to use the littering bags as we would like to have a clean FOP.

Concept of European Indoor Championships 2008, Torino, Italy

Individual competition

- * Qualification: 60 arrows (2X30) at 18M Seniors & Juniors
- * **Only** the athletes competing are allowed **on** the competition field during the qualification round, as well as the allowed number of coaches.
- * A practice field will be available for the divisions not shooting.
- * Eliminations, ¼ & 1/2 Finals: 4 X 3 arrows, 2 min. per end, shot at the main field.
- * **BYES**: Athletes with a bye are **not allowed** to shoot on the competition field.
- * Bronze medal matches will be shot together according to the program. (NO alternate shooting)
- * Only **GOLD medal** matches: 4 X 3 arrows, **alternating** shooting, **30** seconds per arrow, shot in front of the grand stand.
- * A practise field will be available for those archers still **in competition**.

Team competition

- * All members of the team should have participated in the qualification round.
- * Elimination, ¼ & ½ Final rounds: 4 X 6 arrows, **2** arrows per archer and 2 minutes per end.
- * **BYES**: Teams with a bye are not allowed to shoot on the competition field.
- * Only **GOLD medal** matches: 4 X 6 arrows, **alternating** shooting (each end 2 x 3 arrows), and shot in front of the grand stand.
- * During alternating shooting, **every** team **member** shoots **one arrow** before the time is stopped.

General information

- * Always follow the **instructions** given by the judge.
- * **Judges** are there to **help** you. Don't hesitate to contact them if you have doubts about anything concerning the competition. (NOT Transport, Food, Results, Schedule.....)
- * **Appeals** should be handed **as soon as possible** to the **Chairman** of the Tournament Judge Commission.
- * Tell your archers to use the **score boards** on the targets at all time and during **every stage** of the competition.
- * Remind your **archers** they have to **sign** the **score cards** at all times after checking the values and the **total** score.
- * **Back numbers** have to worn at all times during competition (preferably on the quiver or the thigh).
- * **Accreditation** cards have to be worn at **all times**, **NO card; NO access to the field**.
- * A **mistake** on the **score card** may be corrected providing the arrows are **not drawn** and **all the athletes** on that target agree. All archers shall initial the correction.
